The 1 minute video titled "Every Word – Are You Listening?" was posted on YouTube on 9/2/20. John Bradshaw was the speaker.

As you note, the phrase "He that hath an ear, let him hear what the Spirit saith unto the churches" occurs after each of the messages to the seven churches found in Revelation chapters 2 and 3. I've taken the liberty of quoting that out of the King James Version (KJV) though you used the New King James Version (NKJV). There is no significant difference in that phrase between the KJV and the NKJV. It would appear that spiritual deafness is a serious issue. It would have only taken a few seconds more to give the verse that tells what the cure is for spiritual deafness.

"So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God." Romans 10:17 from the King James Version.

I think that's very easy to understand. There are some other popular bible versions that send a different message. Here is that verse from two bibles that were in the top ten position of bible sales as of January 2020.

"So faith comes from hearing, and hearing through the word of Christ." Romans 10:17 from the English Standard Version (ESV).

"Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ." Romans 10:17 from the New International Version (NIV).

When one speaks of the "word of God" the majority of Christians would know that the whole Bible from Genesis 1:1 to Revelation 22:21 was referred to. Since the word "Christ" appears nowhere in the Old Testament, that part of the Bible is eliminated when saying "word of Christ" as in the ESV. You could even take that further; it might mean only the things specifically spoken by Christ were a cure for spiritual deafness.

The NIV says, "word about Christ." That also eliminates, in the mind of some, the Old Testament as being part of the cure for spiritual deafness but doesn't eliminate things written by Paul, Luke, etc. It does, however, admit a plethora of other writings that are "about Christ" that may not be so good.

Think this over carefully. If you had a serious infection that could cause deafness and death such as meningitis, would you wish to receive the antibiotic ordered by the infectious disease specialist or would you like the pharmacist to pick any antibiotic off the shelf and give it to you? The ESV, NIV, NKJV and many other bible versions are fake bibles. Don't try to use a fake bible to cure spiritual deafness.
