The sermon "Lip Synching Gospel Lyrics" was posted on YouTube by Power of the Lamb on 7/25/20. Pastor Ivor Myers is the speaker.

When I posted this on the Power of the Lamb YouTube channel, it appeared it had been accepted but it was later taken down. Some might think it wrong of me to post negative comments on the YouTube comments of Seventh-day Adventist ministers without going to them first. Pastor Myers' channel had 23,900 subscribers at the time this was written. He has promoted a corrupt "Bible" in a public manner and deserves to be called out on it. I'm not going to travel hither and yon, make phone calls or send emails when the convenient way is to comment on his YouTube channel using my own name. If he doesn't wish to listen, it is his loss.

Ivor Myers' YouTube channel is monetized. That means Ivor gets paid for allowing ads on his channel. The ads may be different for different people and the same ad may not come up every time you watch. One of the ads at the beginning of the presentation was for *The Epoch Times* which is a newspaper that exposes political dirt. The next ad showed a series of scantily clad fat women putting on clothes. Then it showed them in a device they wore so they wouldn't look fat. There was a convenient "Shop Now" button to click so you could buy the product at ShaperMint.com.

I'm a bit curious. Around 1:28:59 reference is made to Isaiah 60:11-12. You quote verse 11 from the American Standard Version (ASV) and verse 12 from the King James Version (KJV). Are both those bibles the infallible Word of God? If so, kindly explain the following discrepancy.

"Thou wast the anointed cherub that covereth: and I set thee, so that thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire. By the multitude of thine iniquities, in the unrighteousness of thy traffic, thou hast profaned thy sanctuaries; therefore have I brought forth a fire from the midst of thee; it hath devoured thee, and I have turned thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee." Ezekiel 28:14, 18 from the ASV.

"Thou art the anointed cherub that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast upon the holy mountain of God; thou hast walked up and down in the midst of the stones of fire. Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffick; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee." Ezekiel 28:14, 18 from the KJV.

It's clear that the verses refer to Lucifer who became Satan. The ASV says Satan has been turned to ashes (past tense) and the KJV says Satan will be turned to ashes (future tense). So which is it? Has Satan been turned to ashes? Is Satan dead?

One final question; could you please tell me where I could find "Lucifer" in the ASV?
