On 5/28/20 a video titled "8 Facts About the NEW COVENANT Every Christian Must Know !!!" was posted by Bible Flock Box. Greg Sereda is the speaker.

Greg, we need to review reading in the ENGLISH language. You said, "the Devil is going to be destroyed in the lake of fire at the end of the millennium." The millennium would be AFTER the second coming of Christ. Around 20:06 you quoted a passage and said it was about the Devil and I agree with you.

"You were the anointed cherub who covers; I established you; You were on the holy mountain of God; You walked back and forth in the midst of fiery stones. You were perfect in your ways from the day you were created, Till iniquity was found in you." Ezekiel 28:14-15 from the New King James Version (NKJV).

You then continue with your bible of choice, the NKJV, to show what is going to happen to the Devil

"You defiled your sanctuaries By the multitude of your iniquities, By the iniquity of your trading; Therefore I brought fire from your midst; It devoured you, And I turned you to ashes upon the earth In the sight of all who saw you. All who knew you among the peoples are astonished at you; You have become a horror, And shall be nor more forever." Ezekiel 28:18-19 from the NKJV.

Carefully read what the ENGLISH says in both passages of your NKJV. Ezekiel 28:14-15 is about the Devil who we believe is still alive and active. Ezekiel 28:18-19 is still about the Devil and it says the Devil has been "turned" (past tense) "to ashes." In ENGLISH, that means Satan is already DEAD!

As far as I can tell, Greg is not a pastor but a full time Adventist YouTuber from Poland with 498,000 subscribers to his YouTube channel. Though he speaks impeccable English, he may not appreciate some of the nuances of English words. Many bibles

written in languages other than English have defects; I have no idea what a Polish bible says in the above verses. In addition, he has probably learned some of his Bible expository skills from such as Doug Batchelor and Mark Finley who use the NKJV almost exclusively.

Speaking of Doug Batchelor and Mark Finley; I heard Doug Batchelor reading Ezekiel 28:18-19 from his NKJV bible. When Doug arrived at the problematic part about Satan being turned to ashes, he changed it on the fly from past tense to future tense. Mark Finley wasn't quite so astute; he read from his NKJV, just like Greg Sereda, apparently oblivious to the fact it said Satan had been (past tense) turned to ashes but then said the passage referred to the future punishment of Satan.
