"Walter Veith & Martin Smith – What's Up Prof? – Episode 1" posted on YouTube on 2/27/20 by Amazing Discoveries Africa with Walter Veith the main speaker.

Around 20:23 a discussion starts about "the Bible" and it's said that Protestants used to be guided by it. Then about 21:05 a key Seventh-day Adventist text is posted using the King James Version (KJV).

"To the law and to the testimony: if they speak not according to this word, it is because there is no light in them. Isaiah 8:20 from the KJV.

The English *Sabbath School Bible Study Guide* (SSBSG) for the second quarter of 2020 is titled "How to Interpret Scripture." In that SSBSG ten different bibles are used of which five are Roman Catholic bibles. Let's see how that verse reads in some of them.

"To the teaching and to the testimony! If they will not speak according to this word, it is because they have no dawn." Isaiah 8:20 from the English Standard Version.

"To the law and to the testimony! If they do not speak according to this word, it is because they have no dawn." Isaiah 8:20 from the New American Standard Bible.

"Consult God's instruction and the testimony of warning. If anyone does not speak according to this word, they have no light of dawn." Isaiah 8:20 from the New International Version.

"for teaching and instruction?" surely those who speak like this will have no dawn!" Isaiah 8:20 from the New Revised Standard Version.

"for instruction or a message.' They will surely say some such thing, but what they say has no force." Isaiah 8:20 from the Revised English Bible.

It should be apparent those verses don't say the same thing. The New King James Version (NKJV) is right in the above verse but is wrong in many others. Is it any wonder that what is called "the Bible" is neglected when it is really "the bibles" that are referred to and "the bibles" don't say the same thing? There is only ONE bible in common circulation that can be called a Protestant Bible. The others commonly used including the NKJV are self-contradictory and promote Roman Catholic doctrine.

Unfortunately, many Seventh-day Adventists don't believe any bible is infallible even though the Spirit of Prophecy says, "He is to regard the Bible as the voice of God speaking directly to him." *The Acts of the Apostles* page 475.
