Something very interesting happens starting around 13:22. Ezekiel 28:12-18 is being read from the New King James Version (NKJV). You need to get out your King James Bible if you have one and your NKJV (a lot of you probably have one). The discussion is about Lucifer who became the Devil, the Dragon and Satan. At around 15:39 brother Batchelor gets to Ezekiel 28:18.

Ezekiel 28:18 from the King James Bible - "Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries by the multitude of thine iniquities, by the iniquity of thy traffick; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee."

Ezekiel 28:18 from the NKJV - "You defiled your sanctuaries By the multitude of your iniquities, By the iniquity of your trading; Therefore I brought fire from your midst; It devoured you, And I turned you to ashes upon the earth In the sight of all who saw you."

Brother Batchelor is reading from the NKJV. Notice that verse 18 in the NKJV is in the past tense and in the King James Bible it's in the future tense. Brother Batchelor must have seen a problem because he added a little word that is not in that verse in the NKJV. He said, "And I will turn you to ashes" rather than what it really says, i.e., "And I turned you to ashes."

The NKJV says Satan is ALREADY turned to ashes so must be dead. This is one of the many corruptions in the NKJV. The King James Bible doesn't have this corruption or, for that matter, any other corruption.
