

“CORONAVIRUS: It’s NOT Over!!! – You NEED to Know These Bible Prophecies!!!”

Consider something CAREFULLY. Around 23:23 the point is well made that God has given dietary instruction to help us maintain optimum health. Then Leviticus 11:7-8 is quoted from the New King James Version (NKJV). You need to have a real Bible if you're going to know what God said. So, is the NKJV a real Bible?

Leviticus 11:16-18 from the King James Version (KJV) - "[16] And the owl, and the night hawk, and the cuckow, and the hawk after his kind, [17] And the little owl, and the cormorant, and the great owl, [18] And the swan, and the pelican, and the gier eagle,"

Leviticus 11:16-18 from the NKJV - "[16] the ostrich, the short-eared owl, the sea gull, and the hawk after its kind; [17] the little owl, the fisher owl, and the screech owl; [18] the white owl, the jackdaw, and the carrion vulture;"

Do you notice the problem? The KJV says the swan is unclean but says nothing about the ostrich. The NKJV says the ostrich is unclean but says nothing about the swan. If the swan is unclean, then it stands to reason that other waterfowl such as geese and ducks are also unclean. If the ostrich is unclean, then chicken and turkey are also probably unclean as they have similar dietary habits.

There is another passage that should make clear which bible is the fake.

Mark 7:18-19 from the KJV - "[18] And he saith unto them, Are ye so without understanding also? Do ye not perceive, that whatsoever thing from without entereth into the man, it cannot defile him; [19] Because it entereth not into his heart, but into the belly, and goeth out into the draught, purging all meats?"

Mark 7:18-19 from the NKJV - "[18] So He said to them, “Are you thus without understanding also? Do you not perceive that whatever enters a man from outside cannot defile him, [19] because it does not enter his heart but his stomach, and is eliminated, thus purifying all foods?"

The KJV says food enters a man, goes to the belly (the digestive system) and then goes into the draught (sewer) purging (eliminating) all meats (all foods). The NKJV says the food goes to the stomach and is eliminated and is thus purified (made clean). If you believe food that passes through the digestive tract and is turned to feces has been purified, then you'll probably believe a lot of the other errors in the NKJV.
