Let’s see what Hosea 5:4 says.

“They will not frame their doings to turn unto their God: for the spirit of whoredoms is in the midst of them, and they have not known the LORD.” Hosea 5:4 from the King James Version (KJV).

“Their deeds will not allow them To return to their God. For a spirit of harlotry is within them, And they do not know the LORD.” Hosea 5:4 from the New American Standard Bible (NASB).

Is the NASB a superior translation? It says their “deeds,” which means their sins, won’t allow them to return to God. The KJV says they “will not frame their doings” to return to God. The NASB says they can’t return to God and the KJV says they choose not to abandon their sins and return to God. Which one is correct?
